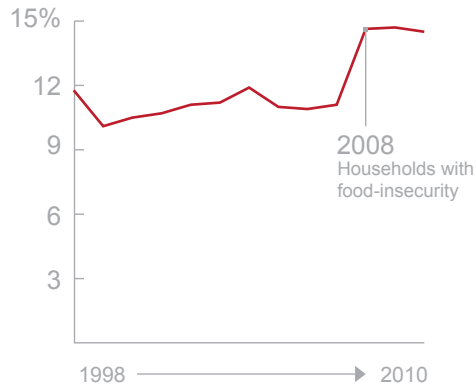

RACE AND ETHNICITY

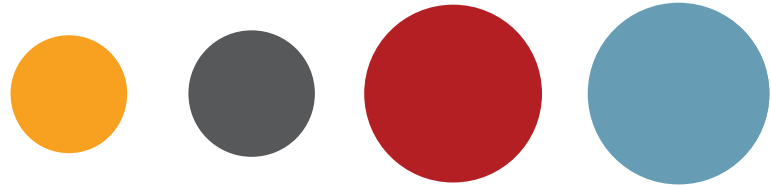
Food insecurity higher among blacks and Hispanics

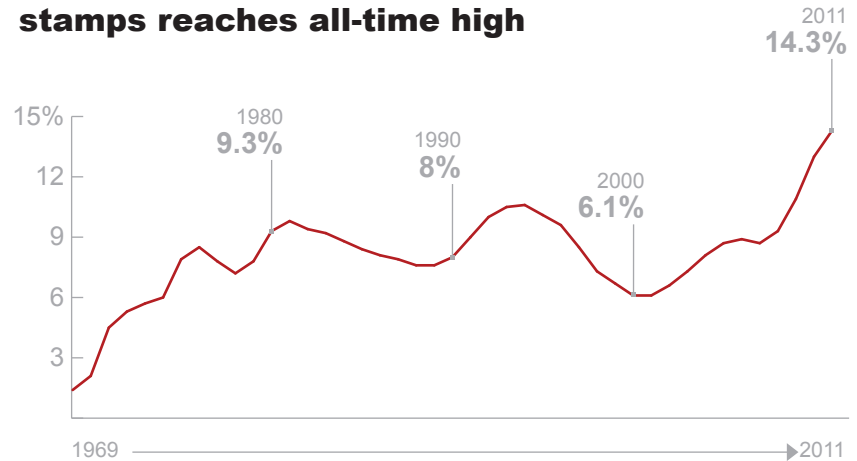
